Important Information:

The property owner or water user shall provide an adequate frost-proof meter connection point; it shall be unobstructed and accessible at all times for reading. Meter pits, if required, shall be of the kind and pattern prescribed by the city. The cost of the water meter and any appurtenances required for the installation of the water meter shall be paid for by the property owner or water user. The City shall furnish all water meters for all water users. Any additional meters will be considered a separate and individual account.

All service line construction, repair, or replacement costs shall be the responsibility of the property owner or water/sewer user.

The lot owner who connects with the public water/sewer shall be held responsible for any damage he may cause to the water, sewer, or public street. If applicable, he shall restore the street to the satisfaction of the Street Commissioner and make good any settlement of the ground caused by the excavation made under and by virtue of any permit issued.

If applicable, **any easements needed to get gain access to City water or sewer lines will be the responsibility of the property owner.** This application does not give the applicant the right to cross private property to gain access to the City lines.
